# Church History



RNCC began hosting Sunday Services at Carolina Pines Community Center.

Raleigh North Christian Center (RNCC) was birthed in the Chapman home through weekly bible studies.

Its first Sunday service was held in a men's halfway house in downtown Raleigh, NC.

RNCC relocated to Lions Park Community Center, near the Raleigh North apartments – inspiring the church's name.





Purchased first campus at 7715 Louisburg Road.

Weekly services began and membership grew to 200.

Membership exploded to over 1,000 members.

Launched *Working the Word* television program featuring Dr. Jeffery Chapman, Sr., growing viewership to over 2 million annually.

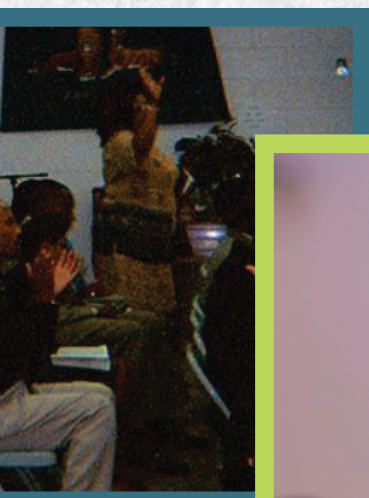
Membership surpassed 250; launched first capital campaign, *Crossing to War*, to fund a larger campus.

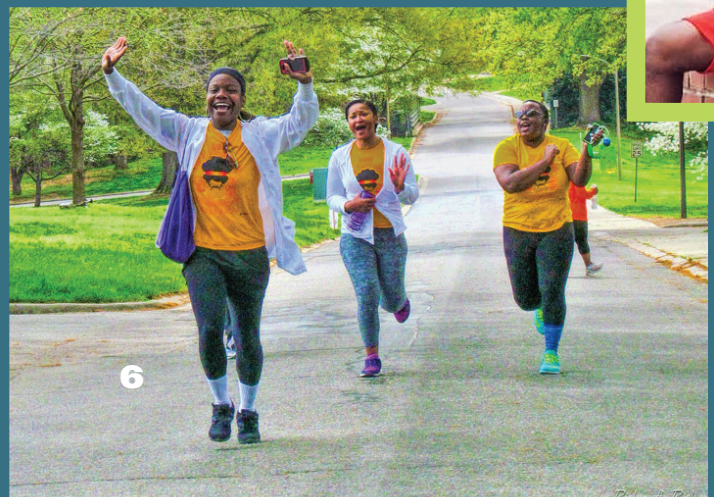

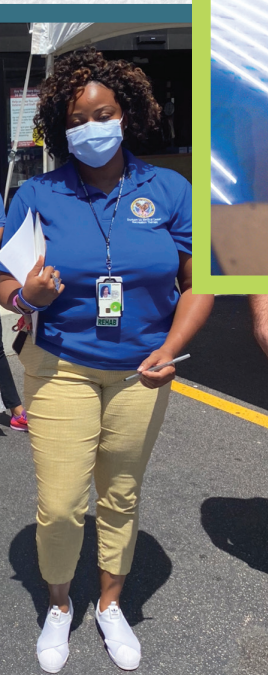

Hosted the inaugural LOL Teen Youth Conference with 200+ teens region-wide.

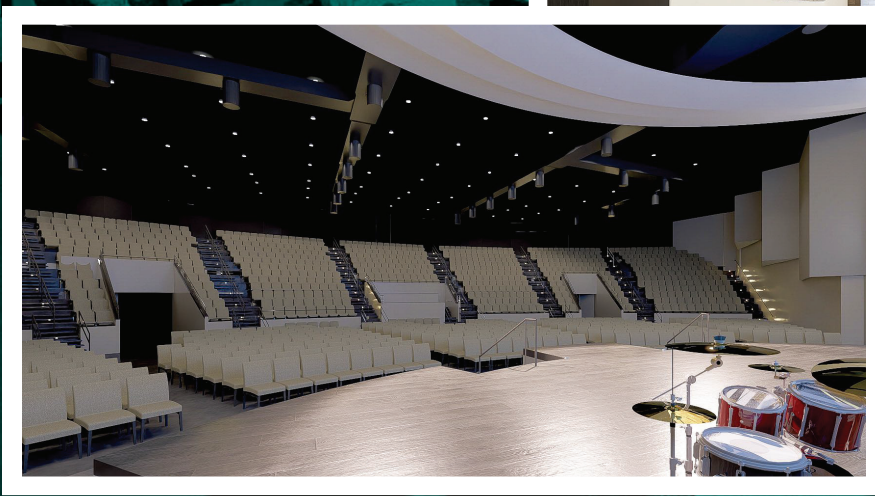
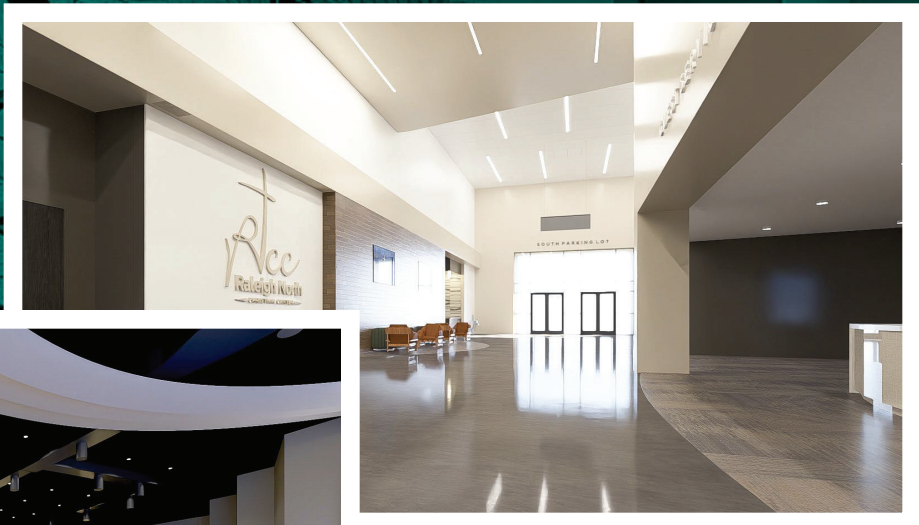


# Vision & Goals

# UNDERSTANDING THE ONE FUND

## A Simple, Unified Way to Give

At Raleigh North, we believe in keeping generosity simple, purposeful, and united.

That's why we're using a **One Fund** approach for **Breakthrough Together**.

Instead of having separate funds—one for ministry operations and another for the building campaign—**everything we give over the next two years goes into one fund.**

This single fund covers all of our ministry and campus needs, allowing every gift to make a direct impact on both our daily ministry and our future campus at Blue Run Lane.

## How the **Breakthrough Together One Fund** Works

- **Total One Fund Goal:** \$11 million over two years
- **Ministry Operations Budget:** \$3.9 million per year
- **Two-Year Operating Total:** \$7.8 million
- **Campaign Portion (for new campus and initiatives):** \$3.2 million

Over two years, this single goal of \$11 million supports **everything God is doing through Raleigh North Christian Center**—from ongoing ministry and outreach to building our new home at Blue Run Lane.

## Why It Matters

The One Fund reminds us that we are:

- **One Church**
- **Serving One God**
- **With One Mission**

Every dollar given fuels worship, discipleship, outreach, and the future home we're building together.

It keeps our focus clear: **every gift counts toward the same mission.**

## Our Vision

Through Breakthrough Together, we're believing in God for more space to serve, more lives to impact, and a future that's built on faith and unity.

When we give through the One Fund, we're not just funding a building—***we build people up*** so we can all live a victorious life. At Raleigh North Christian Center, **we're investing in transformed lives, thriving families, and a growing community of faith.**

# FAQs

## **What is Breakthrough Together?**

Breakthrough Together is a church-wide journey of faith and generosity as we move forward in the vision God has given Raleigh North Christian Center.

## **What are the goals of this initiative?**

Our primary goal is for every household to participate generously toward the vision of RNCC. Each household prayerfully decides how they will respond.

Our secondary goal is \$11 million over two years. This goal includes two years of our current operating budget.

## **What does generosity mean in this initiative?**

Generosity is a prayerful financial commitment, including your current giving toward the Breakthrough Together vision.

## **Where will the generosity given through Breakthrough Together go?**

The resources will support the development of our new campus on Blue Run Lane and the continued ministry impact of Raleigh North Christian Center.

## **Will I still give tithes and offerings?**

Yes, Breakthrough Together represents your total generosity toward RNCC's present and future ministry operations. It combines your tithes, offerings, and new campus giving all into ONE FUND.

## **What is the "One Fund" concept?**

The One Fund approach simply means that all giving to the church (i.e., tithes, offerings, gifts toward the new campus vision, etc.) is received through ONE FUND rather than through multiple, separate funds or campaigns. This means your tithes, offerings, and gifts toward the new campus should be given through the Breakthrough fund.

This model is commonly used by churches and aligns with standard nonprofit and IRS guidelines. Church leadership prayerfully stewards the resources given to support the mission, ministry, and vision of the church.

## **What is the commitment card?**

The commitment card allows each household to prayerfully state their total giving commitment over the next two years.

## **Is the commitment card a contract?**

No. The commitment card is a faith commitment between you and God.

### Who completes a commitment card?

Commitment cards should be completed according to how giving is **handled in your household**. One person may complete the card for the household, or each adult who gives may complete their own card. Each household should also submit their commitment digitally.

*Note: RNCC Kids and RNCC Teens have their own commitment cards as part of their spiritual journey. They can keep or turn these in on Commitment Card Sunday.*

### How do I complete the commitment card?

Pray and decide what your household will give through regular giving and any special gifts, then write the total 2-year commitment on the card. **Also, complete the digital commitment to reflect your written commitment.** Watch the How To Complete a Commitment Card Video.

### When do I turn in my commitment card?

After praying, bring your completed card on **Commitment Card Sunday, May 3rd**. On Commitment Card Sunday, our church family will come together in unity as everyone prayerfully presents their commitment to the Lord.

### When do I begin giving toward my commitment?

Giving toward your commitment begins on **Celebration Giving Sunday, May 17th**. On that day, households are invited to bring their largest seed yet as a sacrificial step toward their two-year commitment.

### How can I give toward my commitment?

To give toward your two-year commitment, select the **Breakthrough Together (Tithes, Offerings, New Campus, etc)** generosity initiative fund. You may give weekly, monthly, or at any time during the two-year commitment period. We encourage you to set up recurring giving. Thank you!

# Testimonials

## Marcus and Temika Amerson

Since becoming members of Raleigh North Christian Center, we have experienced so many defining moments in our lives.

One that stands out happened about three years ago. At the beginning of the year, Marcus wrote out a check to RNCC for almost six figures and placed it on our refrigerator. I glanced at it in passing and asked him what it was for. He said, "That's how much I want us to tithe this year."

Honestly, I thought he was crazy. I asked him if he realized how much we would have to make for that to even be possible. At that time, our accounts were not aligned to tithe that kind of money. The year before, we had both left a company and started our own business, so things were still very new and uncertain for us.

When the year started, things actually began a little slow. But before we knew it, opportunities started coming and business began moving so fast our heads were spinning. By the end of the year, it turned out to be the best year we had ever had in business. When we received our giving statement, we realized something incredible: we had given my entire salary to the church, and we never even felt it.

What that experience taught me was that it wasn't just about giving to the church. It was about trusting God. We say we trust and believe God for so many things in our lives, but sometimes, when it comes to money, that's where the hesitation shows up. But God tells us in His Word to "put Him to the test." Watching Marcus step out with what I called "crazy faith" stretched my own faith. It reminded me that trusting God shouldn't stop when the numbers start to look big.

That year was also the first time we were invited to the Top Financial Leaders RNCC, and looking back, it meant so much, going from the borrower to the lender. And what makes this even more meaningful is that this is the same place that, over a decade ago, poured back into us financially when we were not making the best decisions and truly needed help. Now we get the opportunity to give back to the same place that once supported us when we needed it most.



## Daniel and Shebia Allen

When Daniel and I first began attending Raleigh North Christian Center, we were drawn to the vision of the church and the heart behind its leadership. We appreciated the transparency about the future of the ministry, the goal of moving into a new campus debt-free, and the encouragement for members to participate in building something that would impact future generations. It inspired us to want to grow spiritually while also becoming better stewards of what God has entrusted to us.

From August 2022 to February 2024, we paid off \$139,007.43 in debt. This included:  
\$71,015.00 in car debt  
\$49,301.90 on our mortgage  
\$18,690.53 in credit card debt

What once felt overwhelming became possible through the biblical financial principles we learned in the Financial Learning Experience (FLE) course offered at RNCC.

The course helped us become more disciplined, intentional, and unified in our approach to our finances. Pastor Chapman's teachings on stewardship and honoring God with our resources gave us a new perspective on money and responsibility. The tools and guidance we received helped us build a clear plan and remain consistent over time.

One of the most rewarding parts of this journey has been sharing what we learned with others. Through the knowledge and principles gained from the FLE course, I've helped two people become debt-free and assisted five others in creating plans to begin their own debt-free journeys.

Another powerful principle we embraced during this journey is the importance of giving. Luke 6:38 says, "Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap." As we applied what we learned and trusted God with our finances, we also committed to giving and investing in the vision of RNCC. Supporting the church and its mission has



been incredibly meaningful for us because we have seen firsthand how the teachings, leadership, and resources at RNCC are changing lives, including our own.

Today, being debt-free has brought a sense of peace, freedom, and greater ability to plan for the future. We are grateful for RNCC's commitment to equipping its members not only spiritually, but also in practical areas of life.

If you are considering taking the Financial Learning Experience course, we encourage you to take the step. What once felt like a burden became an opportunity for obedience, and the freedom on the other side is worth every step of the journey.


